

## **STREETLIGHT INFORMATION**

### Background:

Streetlighting was installed in the community at the community's request on or about \_\_\_\_\_.

### How the lights are billed:

As of this writing (May 1999) the county pays the electric bill on most lights. Lights requested after the initial installation by either residents or DPPOA are paid for by the requesting party.

DPPOA pays for the following lights:

- ◆ Beach
- ◆ Boat Ramp
- ◆ Front Entrance Sign
- ◆ Eagle Drive & Walnut Terrace Intersection

### To Have a Light Replaced:

- ◆ Record the pole number (usually a metal tag on the pole) and street name
- ◆ Call SMECO and request the "Service Department"
- ◆ Request SMECO to replace the bulb.

### To Have a Streetlight Relocated:

- ◆ DPPOA does not pay for such requests; they are to be born by the requester.
- ◆ The requester should contact SMECO and request the "Service Department"
- ◆ SMECO will arrange a site visit to work out a solution and bill the requester.
