

TRIMMING TREES IN THE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY:

Per Discussion With Eddie Dichter 05/25/99

How to request help:

- If grading is involved:
 - Complete a grading permit and show the tree location, type, size and estimation of canopy to be removed
 - The grading permit will be circulated to planning and zoning for review of vegetation concerns.
- If no grading is involved:
 - Call planning and zoning direct for assistance / permission.
- No permissions required trimming lower 50% of canopy in critical (non-buffer) areas.
- Newer houses built since 1988 pose special more restrictive cases because they have already used up most of their canopy allocation.

In Buffer Zone or Extended Buffer:

- Charge is \$0.40 / ft² for any reduction in undergrowth and above (no charge for grass)
- No charge if trimming is for safety reasons (such as to allow large vehicles like fire trucks & school buses to pass)

In the Critical Area (Non Buffer / Extended Buffer):

- Charge is \$0.02 / ft² for any reduction in canopy.
- No charge if trimming is for safety reasons (such as to allow large vehicles like fire trucks & school buses to pass)
- No permission required to trim lower 50% of canopy
