

Community Cleanup

A Drum Point hang tag is required in order to take advantage of this benefit. Tags are available in the office the day of the clean up or during business hours.

Calvert County Waste Management has established tighter restrictions on what items can be accepted for disposal. The following types of items **cannot** be accepted at the drop-off:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Tree branches/Yard Waste
- Paints, stains, or other hazardous materials
- Televisions
- Refrigerators

Two dumpsters, one for metal objects and the other for all other types of materials, will be at the vacant lot across from the office on Lake Drive. Please be willing to help unload your vehicle. Members of the board of Directors will also be available to help.
