Note to Applicant: Upgrade costs pertain only to the cost of the engineering, inspection, maintenance contract, remote monitoring for the first five years and costs of adding a nitrogen removal system. All other necessary sewage disposal system costs including conventional tank, distribution network, or effluent dispersal method replacements encountered or required by the local approving authority during the unit installation and post-installation landscaping restoration are to be paid by the property owner/applicant. All applicants are required to have and maintain an actively operating service monitoring system that includes land-line phone service for five (5) years after installation.

Application Instructions for the Bay Restoration Fund Grant – Calvert County –

The following are instructions for completing the “**Bay Restoration Fund – Onsite Sewage Disposal System (OSDS) Application for Financial Assistance**” form. The information below corresponds to the items listed on the application:

- Applicant Name:** Last name and first name of the legal owner of the property. Use the name listed on the tax records.
- Mailing Address:** Provide the mailing address, including the street, city, state and zip code information of the property owner.
- Applicant Phone:** The best phone number to contact the owner or applicant.
- Project Address:** Street or Premise address as indicated on the tax records; include street address number, city, state and zip code.
- Project Location:** Provide the tax identification number (it will begin with an 01, 02 or 03). Provide the Tax Map number; parcel number Section and Lot number(s) (if applicable).
- Contact Person:** Person to contact – if it’s the same as the applicant, please state so.
- Contact Mailing:** Contact person’s street, city, state and zip code mailing address. This is where we will mail appropriate documents.
- Contact Phone:** The Contact’s best phone number.
- Facility Type:** If the house is a single family house, indicate yes. If not, please explain if the house is a multi-family or apartment, etc.
- Dwelling Use:** Is the house your primary residence? Is it occurred full-time or used primarily on the weekend or for short terms (summer, weekend etc)? This will be confirmed with tax record information. Is this application for a new proposed house or one currently under construction (New Construction) or is the house being renovated? If there is no new construction (new or renovation), check **No Alteration**. Indicate the number of bedrooms and if the house is a rental (full time or seasonal), please check **Rental**.
- Prioritization:** The grant requires that properties be prioritized based on location and the need to be upgraded. Please note the type of current septic tank – metal, concrete or other. If the application is for a new home system, check off N/A New Home. Check if this will be an **upgrade** of an older existing system, or a **repair or replacement of a failing or failed system**. Check the box that will allow us access on to your property so it can be evaluated. As of October 21, 2009 only properties with failed or failing systems or metal septic tanks will be considered for the grant. Other applications will be accepted but not evaluated until the grant priorities change.
- Signature:** Finally, the property owner or designated contact must sign and return the form. This will be the first step in being considered for the grant.

That information will be used for bidding your property during the Request for Proposal process. Not all properties will be funded. Properties with zoning violations are not eligible for the grant. Submitting an application does not ensure or guarantee that your property will be awarded the grant. The program is highly competitive.
